

High school students who have completed their junior year and are capable of handling introductory-level university courses are eligible to attend UC Davis Summer Sessions. To be approved to take courses during Summer Sessions, all high school students must submit a completed verification form with their Summer Sessions online application.

Currently, international high school students are NOT eligible to attend.

This form is NOT required if you are over the age of 18.

Before starting the UC Davis Summer Sessions online application, fill out this form electronically. Print, sign and date it. Then, obtain your principal or counselor's signature certifying your grade level and GPA below. This completed form is required to process your application.
